

BYLAW NO. 2-82

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE SNOW RIDGES AND SNOW FENCES


The council of the Rural Municipality of Francis No. 127 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council is hereby authorized to enter upon land adjoining any road allowance or public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges or erecting snow fences as a measure to prevent the blocking of roads by snow drifts during the winter months.
2. The person or persons authorized by council to perform the work as herein provided shall have the right of entry on private property for such purpose only.
3. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the municipality engaged in carrying out the provisions of a resolution passed pursuant to this bylaw, or who destroys, pulls down, alters or interferes with any works carried out or thing done under the authority of this bylaw and any such resolution, shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties prescribed by Section 187 of The Rural Municipality Act, 1972.
