BYLAW 2-90

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Francis No. 127 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. The Council shall establish an emergency measures organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur.
- 2. The Organization shall consist of two branches:
 - (a) The Executive Committee which shall consist of two members appointed by resolution of council. This Committee shall establish policy for the Emergency Measures Organization and appoint a co-ordinator of the organization.
 - (b) The Planning Committee shall consist of officers of the Rural Municipality of Francis No. 127 and such other persons as deemed necessary. The Planning Committee, under the chairmanship of the co-ordinator shall formulate a municipal emergency plan.
- 3. The Rural Municipality of Francis No. 127 shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintainance of the Emergency Measures Organization.
- 4. The Council may co-operate with Councils of other municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operating a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization.
