


BYLAW 2015-01

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR RESTRICTING THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN VEHICLES ON ROADS


The Council of the RM of Francis No. 127 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

This bylaw shall be referred to as the Road Restrictions Bylaw.

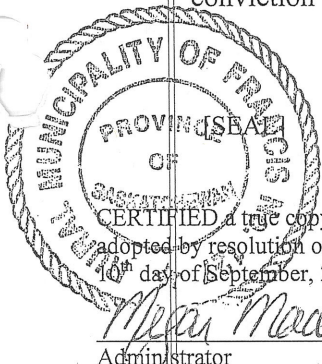
1. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b. "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
 - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Francis No. 127;
 - d. "Order" means an order issued by the road committee;
 - e. "Committee" means a road committee established in accordance with Section 81 of *The Municipalities Act* for the purpose of issuing orders.
2. Council may by resolution establish a road committee for the purpose of issuing orders in accordance with *The Municipalities Regulations Part III*.
3. The committee shall consist of all members of council and each appointment shall be for a term as may be decided by resolution of Council.
4. The Committee may issue an order only if, due to inclement weather or unfavourable road conditions, the use of the road in the manner prohibited by the order would, in the opinion of the road committee reasonably be expected to result in:
 - a. Damage to the road; or
 - b. A high risk of property damage or personal injury to the public.
5. An order established pursuant to this Bylaw may include provision to:
 - a. Prohibit the operation of certain vehicles on specified roads and bridges;
 - b. Restrict the gross weight of vehicles on specified roads and bridges or portions thereof.
6. Subject to the provisions of *The Highways and Transportation Act*, Council may by resolution provide the committee with the authority on behalf of the Municipality to opt in or out of Provincial Road Bans.
7. An Order issued under this Bylaw must:
 - a. Be signed by any two members of the road committee, and the member representing the affected division;
 - b. State the date on which it is signed and the date on which it takes effect; and
 - c. Be filed with the Administrator
8. Upon receipt of the order, the Administrator shall:
 - a. Promptly notify the permit officer in the Ministry of Highways and Transportation of the issuance or the cancellation of any order; and
 - b. Present a copy of the order at the next meeting of council and record so in the minutes.
9. Notice of the order shall be posted conspicuously at each end of the applicable road and at any junction or intersection the committee considers available.
10. Any order issued pursuant to this bylaw shall be in the form of "Schedule A".
11. An order issued pursuant to this bylaw shall remain in effect until cancellation of the order by the committee and all notices posted in accordance with this bylaw have been removed.
12. Any person guilty of any infraction to any of the provisions of this bylaw shall upon summary conviction be liable to a fine pursuant to Section 381 of *The Municipalities Act*.




