DISCRETIONARY USE – AG 2025-236 ILO OPERATION

CR SOLIE: That the Council of the RM of Francis No. 127 approve the proposed discretionary use application for a proposed poultry barn to accommodate 12,000 laying hens for egg production, classified as an Intensive Livestock Operation (ILO), subject to the following conditions;

- a. The operations shall be undertaken in accordance with the approved site plan and within Parcel A, Plan 102179819 Ext 1 (North half of SE & SW ¼ 25-15-15 W2M);
- All structures, manure storage facilities, feed storage, and animal confinement areas shall be undertaken in accordance with the approved application and site plan;
- c. The ILO operator must provide safeguards to prevent noise, glare, dust or odour from affecting nearby properties. Should complaints or issues arise, the ILO operator may be required to implement additional mitigation measures to the satisfaction of Council;
- d. Manure shall be stored and disposed of in accordance with provincial regulations and in a manner that avoids surface and groundwater contamination.
- e. The ILO operator must ensure that the operation is not detrimental to the health, safety, convenience or general welfare of persons residing or working in the vicinity or injurious to property or

- improvements to potential development in the vicinity. The applicant shall be solely responsible for meeting all applicable environmental and legislative requirements, including reporting obligations under provincial and federal law, and must maintain compliance at all times;
- f. Further to the above conditions of approval, prior to construction, the ILO operator must submit an Operations Plan that includes the following;
 - i. Confirm manure management method, manure storage and dryer location. The site plan shall be updated if required to show the dryer location.
 - ii. Mortality management method (incinerator rather than composting) and location.
 - iii. Noise and odour management plan and mitigation plan.
 - iν. Estimated water consumption and water use method used to assess potential impacts on the aquifer, including the conversion of animal units to estimated water consumption volumes.
- g. The ILO operator acknowledges that the current physical access is situated on another owner's property under an existing agreement. The applicant shall be responsible for all future costs associated with construction, improvement, or maintenance of a new physical access or approach, if required; and
- h. A road maintenance agreement with the RM of Francis No. 127 is not required at this time. However, Council reserves the right to require one in the future, at its discretion, should operational changes, expansion, or road condition concerns warrant further review.
